Gola's Year of 2022: Gola in 2022

Gola Culture, Art and Ecology Association addresses the world from the Eastern Black Sea region with a holistic and transdisciplinary perspective. It supports the knowledge production processes by following the traces of ancient cultures so that people can recognize and understand nature. It is also a non-governmental organization engaged in cultural and artistic studies. Since its establishment in 2006, it has been working to mediate the transfer of the ancient knowledge of the peoples of the Eastern Black Sea region and Laz language to the present and the future. Gola, which was headquartered in Beyoğlu between 2006-2021, moved to Rize Fındıklı by the end of 2021 and continues to work locally.

In this direction, the works carried out by Gola locally in 2022 can be grouped under three main headings:

- Networking and community building
- Dissemination of locally produced knowledge,
- Strengthening the capacity of the association around the perspectives of climate crisis and gender equality

Association Internal Management Capacity

Gola Association continued the localization process supported by the European Endowment for Democracy (EED) in 2022. It continued to engage with the local, the national and the transnational. Although it continues its efforts to open its archive to digital access, a significant part of the archive is now accessible.

The Black Sea as a sea workshop and its book, supported by the Heinrich Böll Stiftung Foundation Turkey Representative, was completed. Podcasts supported by Friedrich Ebert Stiftung Foundation Turkey Representation and “Gola Laz Calendar 2023” supported by EU Civil Think are among the important business and event activities of the year. While maintaining these activities, 4 full-time and 1 part-time staff worked.

In 2022, Gola held two workshops titled "Gola Strategy Meeting" and "Gola Projection" to improve its capacity and received consultancy from Yörük Kurtaran with the support of EED.

Institutionalization, Policy and Position Documents

In the 2023-24 period, writing down Gola's internal memory, institutionalization, preparing policy and position papers were prioritized. In this direction, Gola, one of the small grant users of the “Strong Civil Space for Gender Equality” project carried out by UN Women, focused on working on the gender equality policy document between November 2022 and October 2023.

In addition, Gola, who was selected as one of the participants of the Haklara Destek program between January 2023 and December 2024, will also work on transparency, communication strategy, volunteer and member policy documents.

Gola Strategy Meeting

The meeting was held at Ali Rıza Bey Mansion in Hopa, Noveli Culture and Art Space, which was implemented by Gola volunteers and supported by the CultureCivic Fund, on February 25-27. Esengül Ayyıldız and Ferda Önen conducted the study with the support of EED, and attendance of the meeting was Kübra Aslan, İrem Aykut, Gamze Birsan Canoğlu, Didem Dayı, Cemre Erciyes, Didem Gençtürk, Sevilay Refika Kadioğlu, Caner Karataş, Ebru Karataş, Tamer Karataş, Çisem Şendeniz, Özlem Şendeniz, Aycan Şeşen and Nilüfer Taşkın.



“Where Are We Today?, Situation Analysis”; “Where do we want to go with Strategic Planning?”; “How will we reach our goal?”; The report, which was prepared as a result of the discussion around the questions of "How will we do the monitoring and evaluation", has been a guide for Gola's 2023-24 planning.

Gola Projection Meeting

With the support of EED, Yörük Kurtaran conducted the two-day meeting held in Gola Fındıklı office on April 27-28. Aycan Şeşen, Caner Karataş, Çisem Şendeniz, Ebru Karataş, Fatma Genç, İrfan Çağatay, Özlem Şendeniz, Tamer Karataş, Sevilay Refika Kadioğlu participated in the study.

At the end of the meeting, a concept note was prepared to be used in consultancy works that will spread throughout the year. In this direction, in the Eastern Black Sea region of Gola:

- Providing intergenerational communication,
- Sharing its cultural richness by using its tools in its new period,
- Conducted in local and with the possibility of active participation,
- Developing the relationship between the city and the village,
- Dialogue-based and interactive with global problems in different geographies,
- Produces information and classifies existing information in an accessible way,
- Produces model works that introduce the produced to different segments.



Dissemination of Locally Produced Knowledge

Gola cares about compiling local knowledge, specially Laz language, circulating it in different media, and making it accessible and classified in open access. In this context, Gola works to record both its own memory and the memory of the Eastern Black Sea, and to build a bridge between the local and the center based on knowledge and experience.

GolaArchive // An Alternative Eastern Black Sea Memory

The Gola archive, which was classified and digitalize as an output of the "Central to Local to Local to Virtual Gola" project carried out with the support of EED between January 2021 and September 2022, is available at <https://archive.golader.org> as a living archive. The structure, limits and possibilities of the archive are detailed in the text of the manifest, which can be accessed from the site. Different media contents including photographs, videos, audio files and pdf documents related to the Eastern Black Sea Region, Laz language and Gola are accessible in the archive.



The launch of Gola Archive, which aims both to introduce Gola members and to test the search algorithm, took place on September 11th.

Gola Talks

Gola looks at the world from the Eastern Black Sea with a rights-based perspective. Gola speaks to local problems and global issues side by side, together. It is important to for Gola establish an interactive communication between experts, activists and the parties to the problem. In this context, 4 conversations were held under the umbrella of Gola in 2022 within the framework of the right to water, the right to language, women's labor and 25 November International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women.

- On Monday, April 11, the ninth of the Monday Talks took place with Bülent Bilmez and İrfan Çağatay's talk titled "Living Languages and Dialects Despite Everything".
- A film was screened at the Gola Fındıklı office. An interview was held on the zoom platform with the participation of Sheida Kiran, the director of the movie "Harvesting Turkey's Tea".
- On 13 June, the tenth Monday Talks "From Water Right, To Water Right" with Akgün İlhan and Ebru Bingöl was held on the zoom platform.
- As part of the 25 November International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women, the film Persapolis was watched in the Gola office. In this open-call event, violence events in Iran and in local were spoken.

In 2022, 2 new channels were added to the Gola Podcasts supported by the Friederich Ebert Stiftung Association Turkey Representative. Gola Doğu Karadeniz Çalışmaları Grubu olarak uzunca bir süredir Karadeniz'i ve Karadeniz'in etrafında şekillenen yeşilini, doğasını, biyoçeşitliliğini, kültürünü ve dilini yaşatmayı dert edinen işler yürütüyor, bunları kayıt altına almak için faaliyetlerde bulunuyoruz. Bu merak, heves ve biraradalıktan aldığımız güç ile 28-29 Mayıs ve 4 Haziran 2022 tarihlerinde zoom platformunda gerçekleştirdiğimiz çalıştayda farklı disiplinlerden gelen akademisyen, aktivist, araştırmacı ve sanatçı ile buluştuk. Üç güne yayılmış olan çalıştayımızda 5 tematik panel ve 3 sanat oturumu altında toplam 22 sunuş yapılmıştır. Kara'dan Öte kitabımız çalıştayın nihai çıktısıdır.

As the Gola Eastern Black Sea Studies Group, we have been carrying out works that are concerned with sustaining the Black Sea and its greenery, nature, biodiversity, culture and language shaped around the Black Sea for a long time, and we carry out activities to record them. With the strength we derive from this curiosity, enthusiasm and togetherness, we met with academics, activists, researchers and artists from different disciplines in the workshop we held on the zoom platform on May 28-29 and June 4, 2022. In our workshop, which held three days, a total of 22 presentations were made under 5 thematic panels and 3 art sessions. Our book Beyond Land is the final output of our workshop.

Hatice Kapusuz drew the European Robin bird sailing among the calendar leaves, Zeliha Altınay prepared the calendar design and İrfan Çağatay wrote the content. 1000 copies of the printed calendar were distributed free of charge.

Žana Kinçi

Ademi yaratılıp ilk günahı işlediğinde Tanrı Adem'i cehenneme göndermeye karar vermiş. Bütün yaratıklarını cehennem kuyusunun başına toplamış. Bütün mahlukat çok üzülmiş bu duruma, ama ellerinden bir şey gelmezmiş. Tanrı, Adem peygamberin günahlarının kefareti için kim kendini feda eder, diye sormuş. Bütün canlılar susmuşlar, kimse insanlık için cehennemde yanmaya cesaret edememiş. Yalnızca Žana kuşu bütün çelimsizliği ile “Adem ve insanlar için kendimi feda ederim” deyip, Tanrı'nın huzuruna gelmiş. O zaman Tanrı, Žana'ya “Madem öyle at kendini cehenneme” diye buyurmuş. Bunun üzerine Žana kararlılıkla fırlayıp cehenneme ataymış kendini. Tam boynu cehennemin kaynayan katranlı suyuna değdiği sırada Tanrı kuşun samimiyetini anlayıp onu durdurmuş. Ve bu kuşun yüzü suyu hürmetine Adem'i cehenneme atmaktan vaz geçmiş. İşte Žana'nın boynu cehennem ateşine değdiği için kırmızıdır ve o günün hatırasıdır. Bu kızılık, insanlara dünyadaki varlıklarını bu minnacık, zayıf, çelimsiz kuşa borçlu olduklarını hatırlatır. Gök gürelyince sırt üstü yatıp göğün yere düşmesini önlediği de rivayet edilen bu kuşa Türkçe'de kızılgerdan ya da nar bülbülü adı verilir. Rize-Trabzon tarafında ise cennet kuşu, cennetuka, kinalika adının verilmesiyle bu hikayelerden mülahemdir.



-Field Research

In 2022, 3 field research were carried out in Gola.

Looking at Tea Axis of Land, Property and Gender Relations Field Research and Reporting” was realized with the financial support of the European Union by the Gender Equality Solidarity Network, whose short name is AG-DA. With third parties, within the scope of Eren Deniz Tol Research and Advocacy Support , 2 field surveys were carried out in Rize province and its districts in April and August. The prepared report will be circulated in the first months of 2023, and it will be accessible on the website of Gola, a stakeholder of the project, on golader.org.



With the support of Heinrich Böll, field research was carried out on 6-7 August under the title of Black Sea Before the Coastal Road, which is a part of the project "Beyond the Land: Looking at the Black Sea as a Marine Environment". It was held in Artvin-Kemalpaşa and Rize-Pazar with the participation of İrfan Çağatay, Fatma Genç, Melek Göregenli, Tamer Karataş, Özlem Şendeniz and Sevilay Refika Kadioğlu. The results of the research is accessed as a short film on Gola's youtube channel.



Gola's research on the history of the Eastern Black Sea continues with the contribution of the members and volunteers of the association. In this direction, a field study was conducted on 17 November in Artvin-Borçka to locate the remains of a church from the Middle Ages.



Networking and Community Building

Gola locates itself between the local and the global. Gola aims to disseminate its collectively produced works in a peaceful, ecological and just language. Gola not only creates a decentralized communication network in relation to national and transnational networks and actors, but also works for the local Gola community to be visible and active. In this direction, Gola provided consultancy in various projects related to the Eastern Black Sea Region in 2022 and participated in meetings and events. - The Documentarist Istanbul Team provided consultancy regarding the region to the preparation of the CultureCivic application, and became a participant in the project.

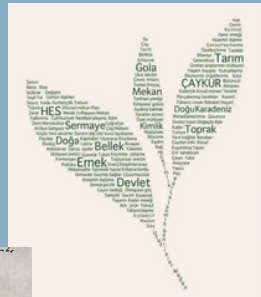
Gola Newsletter
